



This unit comes with 3 x AAA batteries already installed. These are for in-store demonstration purposes only and should be replaced when you get the product home.


- 1 Use a Philips screwdriver to open the battery compartment door.
- 2 Install 3 "AAA" size batteries into the compartment, making sure that the + and polarities match the diagram printed inside.
- 3 Close the battery compartment door and tighten the battery door screw. Don't over tighten.





For the Best Possible Performance
