Installing Batteries

ATTENTION: Batteries should only be installed by an adult Your Pinkie Pie® Animated Storyteller comes with 3 "AAA" (LR03) batteries already installed. These batteries are meant for in-store demonstration use only, and must

- be replaced with new alkaline ones. To replace the batteries:
- The battery compartment is located in Pinkie Pie's[®] belly, protected by a flap. Pull back/separate the flap to expose the battery compartment. Use a Phillips head screwdriver to open the door to the battery compartment.
- 2. Install three "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries into the battery compartment, making sure that the + and polarities match the diagram inside.
- 3. Close the battery compartment door, tighten the battery door screw and close the flap.


