



Installing/Replacing Batteries

- 1. Push to open the battery compartment door located on the bottom of the unit.
- 2. Insert 4 "AA" (LR6) batteries (not included), checking that the + and – ends of the batteries match the drawing inside the battery compartment. We recommend the use of alkaline batteries for longer life.
- 3. Close the compartment cover.

For Best Performance

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Make sure you dispose of batteries properly (see your local regulations).

Listening to an iPod/iPad/MP3 player or other audio device

- Plug the attached audio patchcord located on the back of the unit into the headphone or Line-out Jack on your iPod or other audio device.
