Installing the Batteries

The unit comes with batteries already installed. These batteries are meant for in-store demonstration use only, and should he replaced with freeh batteries. To replace the batteries at home

- 1 Use a Philips screwdriver to open the battery compartment door
- 2 Install 2 "AAA" size hattorios into the compartment making sure that the + and polarities match the diagram printed inside.
- 3 Close the battery compartment door and tighten the battery door screw Don't over tighten

For the Best Possible Performance

- Only use the recommended/supplied batteries or equivalent.
- Use alkaline batteries for longer life
- Do not mix old and new batteries, and do not mix alkaline. carbon-zinc or rechargeable nickel-cadmium batteries.
- Insert batteries with proper polarity (+/-) as indicated
- Bemove exhausted batteries from product.
