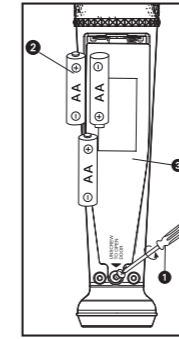

## Installing the Batteries

**ATTENTION:** Batteries should only be installed by an adult.

The unit comes with batteries already installed. These batteries are meant for in-store demonstration use only, and should be replaced with fresh batteries. To replace the batteries at home:

- 1 Use a Phillips screwdriver to open the battery compartment door.
- 2 Install 3 "AA" LRG batteries into the compartment, making sure that the + and - polarities match the diagram printed inside.
- 3 Close the battery compartment door and tighten the battery door screw. Don't over tighten.



## ON/OFF Switch

The unit is shipped in ON position (with Try Me feature). To use the unit, slide the switch to OFF position, then to ON position.

## Playing with the Microphone

### Bluetooth Pairing

- Turn on your Bluetooth device and enable Bluetooth mode (check in Options or Settings).
- Slide the switch on the microphone to the ON position.
- Press the Button to enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
- Using your Bluetooth device, select the Bluetooth pairing name for your product: "ekids B12DP".
- "Connected" will sound to confirm once your device is paired. Put your Bluetooth device in play mode to play audio.
- To manually pair, press and hold the Button for 2-3 seconds.

### Sing a Song

- Press and hold the button to amplify your voice while you sing!

### Built-in Song

- Press the button to play built-in music!

### Echo Effects

- Press the Button to turn echo effect ON/OFF

**Note:** While unit is streaming Bluetooth audio, if no button is pressed, unit will automatically shut off after 5 mins.

Bluetooth will disconnect while built-in song is playing. Press the Bluetooth button to return to Bluetooth mode.

## For the Best Possible Performance

- Only use the recommended/supplied batteries or equivalent.
- Use alkaline batteries for longer life.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, and do not mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable nickel-cadmium batteries.
- Insert batteries with proper polarity (+/-) as indicated.
- Remove exhausted batteries from product.
- Recharge rechargeable batteries under adult supervision.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not open batteries or heat them beyond normal ambient temperatures.
- To prevent battery leakage or damage remove batteries from a product if it will not be used for a month or longer.
